Improving Health Services & Hospitals – Victorian State Electorates

Improving Health Services and Hospitals is a very important issue for many Victorians – led by 38.8% of electors in Narre Warren North, an ALP held seat. This is closely followed by 38.6% of electors in Bass, an L-NP marginal electorate and 36.4% of electors in ALP held Kororoit.

Several other ALP held marginal electorates also rate Improving Health Services & Hospitals an important issue including Brunswick (35.5%), Ripon (33.1%), Forest Hill (32.0%) and Mitcham (31.6%).

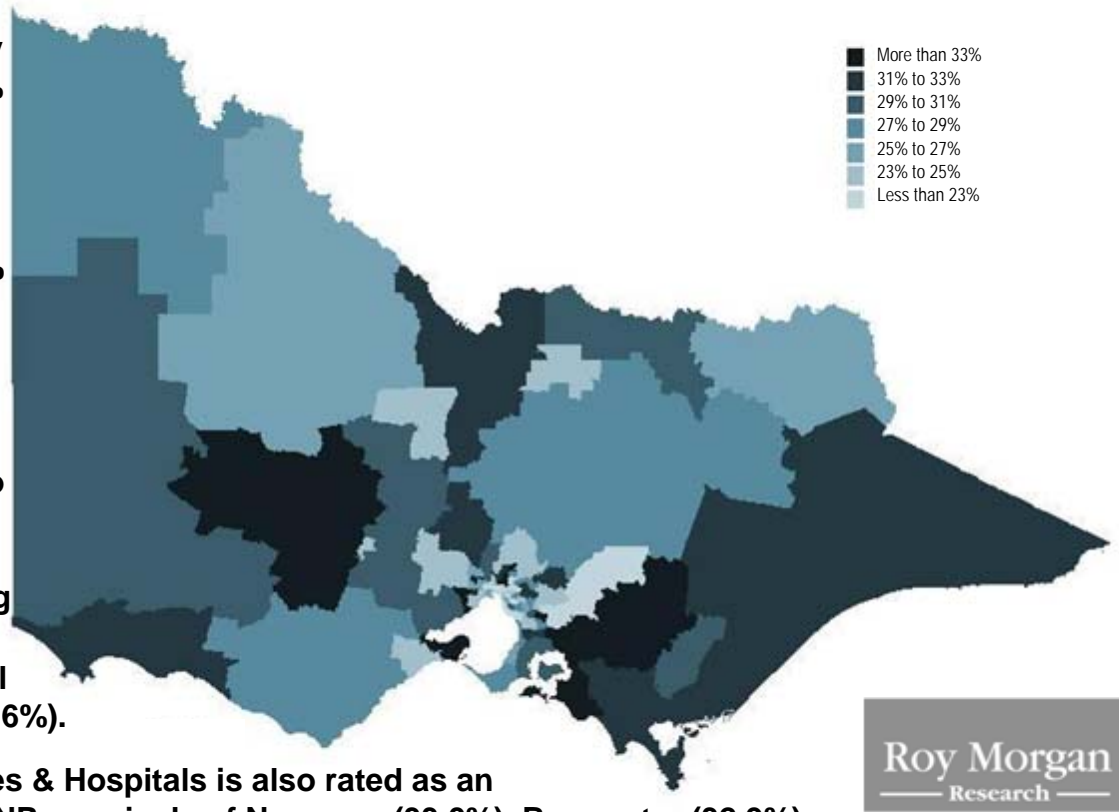
MARGINAL ELECTORATE LINK TO IMPROVING HEALTH SERVICES AND HOSPITALS
